During this retreat style 3 day workshop, we will explore found and collected objects we all seem to gather at different times. We will look into what we can do with our treasures. Found objects can include shells, bits of driftwood, pieces of crockery, buttons, rusty iron, copper bits, feathers and much more.

Our found and collected objects may have stories we like to share. Eco dyeing also fits into this theme, as the vegetation we dye with is most of the time found, collected and stored, such as windfall in parks and bush and sea weed on the beaches, grown in our gardens and saved in our kitchens.

During the workshop there will be opportunities to read short stories and poems. Writing, drawing and meditations may be on the cards too!

The pace will be gentle, the focus on feeling content and relaxed in a peaceful environment.
